

What is a Declarations Page and Why do I need One?

What is a Declarations Page?:

A Declarations Page is a document that shows a summary of your insurance policy and the individuals that it covers. Most Declaration Pages include:

- The Name of the Insured
- Your Policy Number
- The Type of Coverages Offered
- The Limits for Each Coverage
- The Specified Vehicles that are Covered and any Information Describing those Vehicles.

Why does Pivotal Wellness need a Declarations Page From my Insurance Company?:

Pivotal Wellness requires a Declarations Page from every new Personal Injury patient for several reasons. To begin, most personal injury cases are paid for by the victim's insurance company. The at-fault party's insurance company then will reimburse the victim and their insurance company for the costs associated with the care.

We will use the Declarations Page to determine where we should be submitting your treatment plan and the charges associated with that treatment to. It also will inform us of the maximum amount of money that your insurance company will cover before the treatment cost becomes the patient's responsibility. This will also show us what your deductible is related to the treatment costs.
